Auction Chairs/Fundraising – Vacant

- Online Auction has been the main PTO fundraiser the last 7 years
- April 2023 Auction raised \$17,654 for TJ.
- After raising close to \$100,000 the past 7 years, our Co-Chairs have hung up the gavel!
- King Soopers Community Rewards: raised \$6,812 last year with 132 households
- Parent Class Committees: Raise funds for After Prom and senior year activities, plan social events and community building activities

Bus Stop Art Gallery - Robyn Schiff, VP

- In 2016, Denver City Councilwoman Kendra Black provided funding and worked with RTD to build a bus stop near TJ.
- The PTO signed the "lease" with RTD and provides insurance and liaises with TJ teachers and staff to get student art installed quarterly. DECA students provide maintenance.
- A parent is needed to help liaise with the school for quarterly art installations

Spartan Grants Program - Brooke Bolinske

- Last year the PTO funded 21 grants, totaling \$22,645
- Clubs and Activities Supported: Speech & Debate, Flag Football, Unified Sports, SkillsUSA, DECA, ROTC, Student Activities Advisor Fund (provides snacks and lunch so teachers don't have to pay for this themselves)
- Departments/Classrooms Supported: Art, CCT (grants for Robotics, Audio Production, Journalism), Math (Problem of the Week Program), Science (Physics), Exceptional Student Services (field trip funds), Student Support

(School Social Worker and Counselors)

• The PTO has provided over \$60,000 in grants in the last 4 years!
