- 2. Celebrations
 - a. Lots of new students still enrolling, lots from out of country
 - b. In the process of hiring a Spanish speaking Paraprofessional
 - Maker Fair on 12/6 in the evening (used to be a CCTM showcase)
 Maker Fair is student run and will be a great opportunity to highlight the programming at TJ
 - d. 22 state qualifiers for DECA
 - e. Saturday School has been very successful (this past week we had 57 students attend), non punitive, snacks and tutoring provided

 - 1. Priority is to not cut classroom teacher position
